



DEGAS (1834-1917), in his pictures of backstage life at the Paris Opera, has immortalized the old-school ballet in the period of its greatest artificiality and elegance. Degas devoted hours on end to watching the ballet girls work in the school, in the practise rooms, at the Opera, and on the stage during rehearsals. Completely disinterested in the spectacle of light and motion that presented itself to the audience, he painted the sweat and fight of dancing.
